TRANSPACO LIMITED: SUSTAINABILITY INITIATIVES AND ESG IMPLEMENTATION

Transpaco has undertaken a series of formal steps towards advancing its sustainability objectives and improving transparency across its operations. As part of this journey, GSA Campbell has been appointed to facilitate the company's ESG and sustainability implementation process, supported by the Veriport ESG software platform.

The process has included a high-level double materiality assessment, which considered impact and financial materiality impacts. This has enabled Transpaco to identify the most material ESG themes relevant to its business and stakeholder expectations.

Based on these themes, key ESG metrics have been identified for tracking and disclosure. These include both qualitative and quantitative indicators and have been customised to reflect the unique operational contexts of Transpaco's divisions and subsidiary companies.

The Veriport platform has been selected and implemented as the group's central ESG management and reporting tool. This platform enables ESG data capture at site level, facilitates reporting aligned to globally recognised standards, and supports progress monitoring over time. Transpaco has aligned its reporting to the GRI Standards, which are globally applicable and widely regarded as a credible framework for sustainability disclosures.

In addition, Transpaco has commenced the process of measuring its carbon emissions in accordance with the GHG Protocol, covering Scope 1, Scope 2, and selected Scope 3 activities. While it is early in the process and a full carbon report is not yet available, boundaries are being defined and data is already being entered into the system. This will form the basis for baseline carbon footprinting and ongoing climate-related reporting.
